If you need materials such as bulletin board and/or construction paper, scissors, and glue in order to complete the project, please let me know. I will be glad to send items home with your child. **This assignment is due no later than Tuesday, March 19, which is after Spring Break.** If your child finishes their box building before March 19, they may bring it to school and we will begin to set up our Box Town. Thank you for your participation with this fun assignment!
